A Master Plan outlines a community’s vision for the future and then describes concrete, specific action steps that community leaders can undertake to accomplish them. Conducting a Master Plan allows public officials to assess whether the policies and actions they are presently taking are addressing needs and accomplishing long-term goals.

Master Plans can cover a wide range of topics including transportation, housing, economic development, parks and recreation, the environment, business districts, and quality government.

#### Our Process:



##### Analyze the Community Survey

County Planning will conduct a sample survey to gain a better understanding of the strengths, issues, and future needs within the community.



##### Assess your Current Conditions

County Planning will collect data on demographics, land use, and transportation as a baseline for understanding your community.



##### Articulate a Vision

With input from residents, businesses, and community leaders, we will articulate a vision for how you want to grow and change in the next decade.



##### Develop an Action Plan

Based on the community vision, County Planning will identify specific policies and actions to accomplish your goals.



##### Assign Responsibility for Action

We will outline strategies, responsibilities, and priorities for implementing the action plan.
